In response to your query concerning Mr. Moss's tenure at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center, I can tell you the following:

Mr. Moss was hired at MSKCC on June 3, 1974, as a science writer. He received a summary discharge on Nov. 21, 1977. He held the same position at the time he left MSKCC. The job was classified as M-7, which was ranked at the lower end of the professional pay scale. He did not serve as either associate or assistant director of public affairs at this institution, according to available records. Science writers currently on staff do not have supervisory responsibilities.
